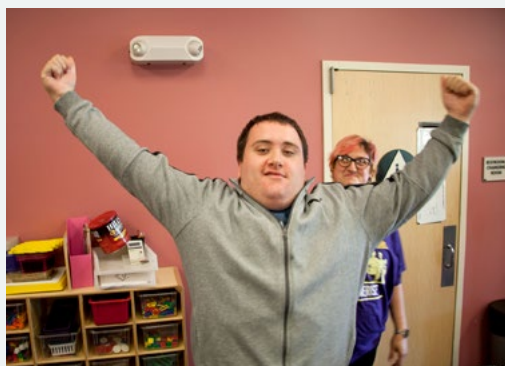

**Fee: \$80 (one semester unit for attending both days of the conference)**

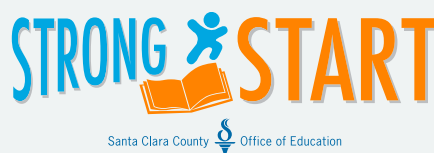

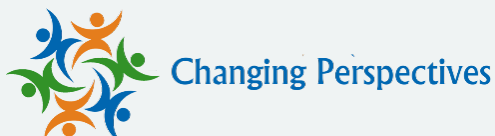
